➤ **Be A Group Leader**

Facilitate and lead group rotations for track and field events, be a runner who will give the scores to the PA announcer, or be a score keeper who will record the athletes' results. Be a role model by promoting a positive attitude about vision loss and encouraging independence in blind youth. Several group leaders will be assigned to each group. An orientation meeting is mandatory and will be held before the games begin on the day of the event.

➤ **Be A Field Events Facilitator**

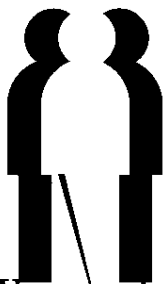
This is your opportunity to coordinate and adjudicate at a specific event, such as the 50-yard dash, javelin throwing, shot put, discus throwing, and broad jump. Some experience as an athlete or running events in the past will be useful. Attendance at one orientation and training session is mandatory.

➤ **Work A Booth**

We will need people to help register participants, sell T shirts, distribute water, and conduct the various awards' booths. An orientation meeting is recommended.

➤ **Be a Part of the Set up and Breakdown Crew**

Help with setting up chairs, tables, booths, demonstration area, and field events. Work together with the crew to breakdown equipment and clean up the field following the event.
